

Agricultural GDP by Sub-Regions and their Share, 2014










Share of Agricultural Employment in the OIC and World

Agricultural Exports and Imports in the OIC










Crops Production in the OIC and its Share in the World

Meat Production in the OIC and its Share in the World



GDP at 2005 Prices



Labor Productivity in the OIC and World



Food Security Index

Global Food Security Index, 2016

- □ The Global Food Security Index considers the core issues of affordability, availability, quality and safety across a set of 113 countries.
- □ The overall goal of the study is to assess which countries are most and least vulnerable to food insecurity through the categories of Affordability, Availability, and Quality and Safety.
- □ All index scores are normalized on a scale of 0-100 where 100=most favorable.


